Old workhouse graves: In the work on the site for the new Down High School a total of 943 bodies were discovered in single and mass graves. You may have read about this in the local press.

On October 20th in the company of Mrs. Perry, Principal of the High School, Canon Murray, Dean Hull and Mr. Richard Daniels (representing the Baptist and Presbyterian churches) conducted a prayer service at the site. The bones of the deceased were reinterred in a new designated site which was duly consecrated and blessed. This site is quite close to the already existent walled area which has many graves from the past.
