Evening Masses: Monday & Wednesday 7.30pm (Open to the Public), Friday at 7.30pm are ONLINE ONLY.

Sunday Masses:

Saturday (Vigil) 5.30pm - Open to the Public

Sunday 9am (ONLINE ONLY), 12 Noon – Open to the Public.

The Church will be closed immediately after each Mass and will open Monday – Saturday 1pm – 4pm and Sunday 2.30pm – 5.00pm for private prayer.

EASTER WATER: will be blessed at the Vigil on Holy Saturday Night. Due to current restrictions, parishioners WILL NOT be able to take any water using their own bottles. Holy Water will be available from Easter Sunday - We ask that you cover the cost of the bottle – a small bottle is £1 and the larger bottle is £2. If you purchase a bottle please DO NOT TOUCH any bottle other than the one you are buying, leave the money in the white box at the sanctuary.
