Holy Land Christians: Dear Parishioners we are all sadly aware of the terrible events in the Holy Land since the massacre on October 7th. I am sure we are praying for peace in this situation. I am sure also that many of you – as I have – already have contributed something – however small – to the humanitarian aid needed in Gaza. However there is a third group in that land which is also suffering and that is the small Christian population – roughly 1% of the entire Israel population.

All pilgrimages to the Holy Land have ceased for now and the foreseeable future. This is the lifeblood of many of these communities of Christians in the area of Bethlehem and Tiberias. There is talk of many of the younger Christians leaving the land of their birth and emigrating.
