

RESCHEDULING OF MASSES IN THE PARISH OF ST. PATRICK'S DOWNPATRICK - 2023

Recently Bishop Donal McKeown our apostolic administrator issued a pastoral letter on the feast of Pentecost. I hope you have been able to read it either as a copy in the church or online at the various parish platforms (Facebook,app,website)

Bishop Donal's letter was very positive but also challenging in terms of the future of our diocese and the provision of the sacramental occasions to which we have become accustomed.

Recently in our own parish over the last few months we have had to provide cover for neighbouring parishes for priests who were sick or who needed a break. This is something we are pleased to be able to do but it wasn't easy and it won't be possible to continue this indefinitely.

In order to be able to provide cover in a neighbouring vicariate parish (we are in the vicariate of Downpatrick and Lecale) I want to suggest a rescheduling of our own Masses times. To an extent we have been doing this already over the last year since Covid eased. But I wish to make further 'tweaks' to the schedule.

I propose this for two reasons –(a) to enable one of the priests of the parish to be more easily free to cover another parish should there be a need and (b) to maximise the attendance at our own parish Masses. So instead of having four or five local parish Masses with attendances of 120,100,47,200,35 as at present we could have two or three Masses with larger congregations. Our recent Mass survey showed that about 600 people in the parish attend Mass regularly.

This is the current situation

St. Patrick's 5.30 Vigil 9.00 12.00

With St. Brigid's on two Saturdays and St. Malachy's and St. Colmcille's on two Sundays (all at the usual times)

This is the proposal I suggest we move to at the beginning of September.

St. Patrick's 5.30 (vigil) and 11.00 (Sunday)

With one Mass each Saturday/Sunday in either St. Brigid's. St. Colmcille's or St. Malachy's so as to allow access for parishioners who find the steps at St. Patrick's difficult.

The Mass schedule for each month is available in the Parish Bulletin, on our Facebook page, the website and via the Parish App.

Change is never easy. Some people might be disappointed or annoyed that their preferred Mass time is not available but I hope you can appreciate the need for the change. I would welcome any feedback on the proposal. You can give this either by email or by phoning the parish at 44-612084.
