

# Confessions in Advent St. Patrick's Parish Downpatrick:

The beautiful Advent Tradition, Bambinelli Sunday, was instituted by Saint Pope John Paul II during his Papacy. The tradition follows that on the Third Sunday of Advent (Gaudete Sunday) children and adults bring their Baby Jesus figures from their homes to St Peters Square where they are blessed by the Pope. All children and families are invited to bring the Baby Jesus figure from their homes to be blessed. Families can make their own 'Bambinelli' if they wish. Parishes around the world now join in the celebration, encouraging young children to make the connection between the Nativity set at home and the local church where they worship each weekend. "It helps children and young people to prepare for Jesus." (Pope Francis) A suggestion is, following the blessing, take your 'Bambinelli' home, wrap it and open it as a family on Christmas morning where the youngest member of the family would place it in the crib. A gift of the presence of Christ in your home this Christmas. Parishioners are invited to bring the 'Baby Jesus' to the 10:30am Mass on Sunday 17th for a blessing.



**800 Years!** This year is the 800<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the very first crib. Way back in 1223 St. Francis of Assisi set up the first crib in the Italian town of Greccio near his home town of Assisi. When you set up your crib this year you are part of a wonderful tradition.
