

Reintroducing the Programme for Baptism: As part of our Faith Development in our Parish, we will be reintroducing the Programme for the Sacrament of Baptism from November 2023. The dates for these courses along with the Baptism application form and further important information can be obtained from the Parish Office, Tel 02844612084 or via the parish App. At the time of making your booking with Mary, the Parish Secretary, you will be invited to attend Mass on a Sunday before your baby's Baptism when your child will be introduced and welcomed into to the Parish Community.
