

Masses in St. Patrick's – DON'T LOSE YOUR VOTE! This weekend at Mass – you will have the opportunity to vote for the time of Mass you would like from September 1st. Parishioners at the 5:30pm Mass can vote either for 5:30pm or 6:00pm.

Parishioners at 9:00am and 12Noon Masses can vote either for 10:30am or 11:00am.

We will publish the results in the following week's bulletin. Email & postal votes have also been noted. Parish Draw: As you know the parish draw was due to be launched again in April 2020. But owing to the Covid pandemic it had to be suspended because our promoters would have been unable to make their returns. Recently, after a meeting with Canon Murray the promoters decided to re-launch the draw in October 2023. It was decided to have only one draw with 31 prizes on the basis of the returns that had been received by March 2020. If anyone still wishes to become a member the final closing date for receipts will be 31st August 2023. The prizes will be: £5000, £2000, 6 x £1000, 10 x£200, 5 x £100, 8 promoters prizes of £30 - a total of 31 prizes, amounting to £15,740. BANKERS ORDERS: Those who paid by Bankers Order should cancel their order with their bank with immediate effect, those who have over subscribed on Bankers orders' will have the extra money refunded by cheque. With regards to the method of drawing winners, members who have paid £60, will receive 12 tickets, those who paid £30, six tickets, those who paid £5 one ticket, i.e. One ticket for every £5 paid in. We hope members will be satisfied with these methods of completing the final Draw, which has been disrupted by the difficult circumstances caused by Covid. Owing to the fact that some of our promoters are ill and some are no longer collecting the draw in October will be the last one. Many thanks to all our promoters and members for helping to make a success of the draw over the last few years. The draw brought in a substantial amount for the parish. As you know, the Relationships and Sexuality Education (Northern Ireland) (Amendment) Regulations 2023 force all post-primary schools in Northern Ireland regardless of the school's ethos — to teach girls that they have a right to abortion and how they can get one without the knowledge of their parents.

This law tramples on the rights of parents, will destroy the innocence of children and cost the lives of an untold number of unborn babies. As part of our efforts to have it overturned, we are holding a very important meeting for everyone who objects to abortion lessons in Northern Ireland's schools. The aim of the meeting is to send an unequivocal message to the Government in London:

The new law on RSE must be withdrawn and no further measures introduced without a full public consultation. Please make this meeting a priority and come along. We cannot stay silent as the London Government imposes this shocking regime on our schools, a regime that threatens to grow progressively worse unless we stop it now.
