

Church Unity Service in St. Patrick's Church on Sunday 21st January 2024 at 7:30pm with participation of the Christian Churches in Downpatrick. Guest preacher: Fr. Andrew Black (lecturer – St. Mary's College Belfast).

The beautiful Advent Tradition, Bambinelli Sunday, was instituted by Saint Pope John Paul II during his Papacy. The tradition follows that on the Third Sunday of Advent (Gaudete Sunday) children and adults bring their Baby Jesus figures from their homes to St Peters Square where they are blessed by the Pope. All children and families are invited to bring the Baby Jesus figure from their homes to be blessed. Families can make their own 'Bambinelli' if they wish. Parishes around the world now join in the celebration, encouraging young children to make the connection between the Nativity set at home and the local church where they worship each weekend. "It helps children and young people to prepare for Jesus." (Pope Francis) A suggestion is, following the blessing, take your 'Bambinelli' home, wrap it and open it as a family on Christmas morning where the youngest member of the family would place it in the crib. A gift of the presence of Christ in your home this Christmas. Parishioners are invited to bring the 'Baby Jesus' to the 10:30am Mass on Sunday 17th for a blessing.

Holy Land Christians: Dear Parishioners we are all sadly aware of the terrible events in the Holy Land since the massacre on October 7th. I am sure we are praying for peace in this situation. I am sure also that many of you – as I have – already have contributed something – however small – to the humanitarian aid needed in Gaza. However there is a third group in that land which is also suffering and that is the small Christian population – roughly 1% of the entire Israel population. All pilgrimages to the Holy Land have ceased for now and the foreseeable future. This is the lifeblood of many of these communities of Christians in the area of Bethlehem and Tiberias. There is talk of many of the younger Christians leaving the land of their birth and emigrating. If anyone would like to give something for the Christians of the Holy Land please put it in an envelope marked 'Holy Land Christians' and leave it in the church boxes or the presbytery. I will ensure this reaches a group called 'Friends of the Holy Land' which supports all Christians in the Holy Land. Please continue to also pray for them.
