Downpatrick Pro-Life are holding an outreach event in Downpatrick Town Centre on **Saturday 7th October from 12.00 to 2.00pm**. Please join us in defending unborn babies and supporting families. Reintroducing the Programme for Baptism: As part of our Faith Development in our Parish, we will be reintroducing the Programme for the Sacrament of Baptism from November 2023.
