Presentations covering Copyright and Music Licensing will be held at the following venues from 7.30pm until 9pm. Tea/coffee will be served from 7pm.

**Safeguarding Sunday.** Today is Safeguarding Sunday. In his pastoral letter about Safeguarding in Down and Connor, Bishop Mc Keown wrote: "Safeguarding Sunday is an opportunity to highlight the fact that Safeguarding is a vital ministry that touches all aspects of Parish life. It is a responsibility shared by all of us, making our Parishes and Church Spaces safe and welcoming for young people and adults at risk." The full content of the letter is on the Parish web site. He also draws attention to the recent National Board report on Safeguarding in Down and Connor. That report can be accessed by the Down and Connor web site and Parish App. Current Members of the Safeguarding Committee are: Canon Murray, Fr. Henry, Patricia Magee, Carmel Fitzsimons and Colette Connor. We aim to

- 1. Create a safe environment for all our parishioners and those who use church premises.
- 2. We aim to create awareness among all our clergy, staff and volunteers of the key message of Safeguarding.
- **3.** We ensure that all who carry our specific roles in our Parish with children or adults have the knowledge and skills to carry out their role.
- 4. We organise training and vetting through the Safeguarding office in Belfast for those parishioners who need it.
- **5.** We carry out an annual audit of Parish and external groups who use Parish premises. This was submitted last week.
