

SCAM ALERT: One of our Parishioners was recently contacted by text message telling her that she had been in touch with someone who had tested positive for Omicron – she was asked to book a PCR test ASAP Via a link in the text message, which she did, however, at the time of booking, she was asked for her bank details as although the PCR Test was free, postage had to be paid for. After entering her bank details, the lady spoke to a family member who advised that the text was a scam and suggested she should contact her bank immediately – she did this and was told that a member from her banks fraud team would contact her with advice and support – a while later 'The Bank' did ring her and run through various support/advice scenarios, towards the end of the call, 'The Bank' told the lady that her phone had been contaminated by the scam text message, but that they had been authorized by her telephone provider to resolve her phone issues – at this point the lady asked for a case ref number so that she could call her bank back... the caller terminated the call! The lady thankfully spoke to the fraud support team at her 'Real Bank' later in the day and get reassurance from them.

Readers and Eucharistic Ministers: Since restrictions due to Covid eased we have been able to return to a near normal liturgy. However, some of our former readers and Eucharistic ministers feel they can no longer provide this valuable service. For instance, currently we have only one reader for Sunday's 12:00pm Mass.
