



Holy Land Christians: Dear Parishioners we are all sadly aware of the terrible events in the Holy Land since the massacre on October 7th. I am sure we are praying for peace in this situation. I am sure also that many of you – as I have – already have contributed something – however small – to the humanitarian aid needed in Gaza. However there is a third group in that land which is also suffering and that is the small Christian population – roughly 1% of the entire Israel population. All pilgrimages to the Holy Land have ceased for now and the foreseeable future. This is the lifeblood of many of these communities of Christians in the area of Bethlehem and Tiberias. There is talk of many of the younger Christians leaving the land of their birth and emigrating. If anyone would like to give something for the Christians of the Holy Land please put it in an envelope marked 'Holy Land Christians' and leave it in the church boxes or the presbytery. I will ensure this reaches a group called 'Friends of the Holy Land' which supports all Christians in the Holy Land. Please continue to also pray for them. Safeguarding: The safeguarding Committee continue to work to maintain good practice within our parish. Our mission is to recognise and uphold the dignity and rights of all children and adults. We are committed to ensure their safety and wellbeing. We have continued to work since the resumption of normal activities in the Parish after COVID. A recent parish audit carried out with 25 internal groups and 6 external groups using parish premises has been completed. All clergy, parish staff and volunteers who needed to have been re-invited. Training for all personnel is in the process of being completed. Information about parish groups is at the back of St. Patrick's Church (beside the stairs to the gallery) or on the parish app or may be obtained from the parish office. All information regarding safeguarding is on all the notice boards in each church. We would like to remind you, that if you enter the sacristy you must sign the attendance register. This includes Eucharistic ministers getting hosts before Mass.
